### STeP Fellowship Program 2025 -2026

- Time frame: August 2025 May 2026
- Thematic Areas:
- 1. Drought
- 2. Bioeconomy/Sociobioeconomy

- Training:
  - -2-4 hours per month in synchronous sessions and group work science diplomacy projects (completion of course is not a requirement; encouraged for the certificate)
- Cohort structure









#### IAI Responsibilities

- Provide fellows with an orientation
- Develop and provide STeP Fellows with one-year professional development of Transdisciplinary Leadership, Communication and Science Diplomacy
- Invite fellows to participate in at least one international event during the fellowship (workshops, meetings, conferences and congresses of the IAI or partner institutions)
- Maintain the Inter-American network of fellows, host institutions and countries and IAI alumni









#### **Host Institution Responsibilities**

- Provide institutional conditions for fellows to develop their work program and impact plan, including definition of a supervisor at the host institution who will support/supervise the fellow's work for the duration of their program
- Fund fellows' stipends
- Fund the program fee by transfer to the IAI according to the following structure:
  - a. USD \$5,000 for one (1) fellow
  - b. USD \$7,500 for two (2) fellows
  - c. USD \$9,500 for three (3) fellows
- Fund the fellow's travel to at least one international meeting









### IAI and Host Institution Shared Responsibilities

- Design the call for fellows and its dissemination
- Joint selection, if necessary, of fellows
- Approve the fellows' work plan or any modification in term of topics, objectives and activities
- Establish the group of mentors that will support the work and development of the fellows who have experience in science and decision making processes
- Supervise the work of the fellows during the STeP program
- Organize at least one meeting to plan, evaluate and manage any issues of the collaboration, interaction with fellows, supervisors and mentors
- Jointly seek funds to support additional program activities
