

Launch of an International Monsoons Project Office to Support Global Monsoon Research Coordination

An agreement was signed in July 2021 between *the Secretary-General of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and the Director of the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM), an Autonomous Institute under the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Government of India,* to host an **International Monsoons Project Office (IMPO)** at **IITM.**

IMPO is a joint effort by **WMO** and **IITM** to help coordinate the global monsoon research activities of the **World Weather Research Programme** (WWRP) and the **World Climate Research Programme** (WCRP).

To commemorate the launch of the IMPO, a celebratory event is being held online on **28 February 2022 at 13:00 UTC (1830 IST)**, coinciding with the National Science Day in India.
