Science Highlights

Impact of a Future Hydrogen-Based Road Transportation Sector on Stratospheric Ozone

D. Wang and coauthors investigate the potential impact of a hydrogen-based transport sector on stratospheric ozone in a recent article published in Atmospheric Chemistry and Physics. The model simulations show that in all cases a hydrogen-based transport fleet would decrease stratospheric ozone as a result of perturbed catalytic ozone destruction cycles... read the article

Seasonal Hindcasts for Scientific Research

The WGSIP in collaboration with the Centro de Investigaciones del Mar y la Atmosfera invites the research community to explore the Climate Historical Forecast Project (CHFP) database for their studies on the seasonal predictability of the global climate system. The Challenge in Reducing Uncertainty in Climate Model Projections

As one of the main modulators of energy in the atmosphere, clouds control many aspects of the climate system. Limited understanding of clouds is the major source of uncertainty in climate sensitivity. Over the next 5-10 years WCRP will focus on overcoming the main barriers to progress in determining the role of clouds in Climate Sensitivity and future precipitation changes... read more

Nature Article on Ice-sheet Mass Balance and Climate Change

Since the 2007 Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change Fourth Assessment Report, new observations of ice-sheet mass balance and improved computer simulations of ice-sheet response to continuing climate change have been published. Whereas Greenland is losing ice mass at an increasing pace, current Antarctic ice loss is likely to be less than some recently published estimates.... read the article

Shifts in Climate Zones Accelerated by Global Warming

A recent study published in Nature Climate magazine suggests that the pace of shifting regional climate zones increases approximately linearly with the increasing global temperature. This implies that species will have increasingly less time to adapt to zone changes in the future, thus increasing the risk of extinction... read the article

Global Warming or Climate Variability?

An interesting debate is currently taking place on whether the 2012 US Central Great Plains drought is linked to climate change or it is a result of natural climate variability. The debate sparked after the publication of the NOAA assessment report on the origin of such drought and it involves several WCRP affiliated scientists... follow the debate
