# 1. Event date, Venue and Accommodation

The main event will be held on 15-18 July 2025 at the Lotus Conference Hall on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, <u>APEC Climate Center</u> in Busan, Republic of Korea. Breakout sessions will be held in the Lotus Conference Hall and Edelweiss Room on the 2nd floor, as well as the Cosmos Room on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.

# Room Capacity:

Lotus Conference Hall on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor: 65 ~ 70

Edelweiss Room on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor: 29 Cosmos Room on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor: 15

There are hotels within walking distance from the meeting venue and hotel recommendations can be found on the meeting website.

# 2. Transport

From Gimhae International Airport, there are multiple transport options: -

#### (1) Option 1

Take airport **limousine buses** heading to Haeundae run every 30 minutes from 04:40 to 22:00 (Bus fare ₩ 7,000) -> Get off at Bexco station -> Take a taxi and ask the driver to go to the APEC Climate Center or show the address in Korean (APEC 기후센터 부산광역시 해운대구 센텀 7 로 12) (Taxi fare: approximately ₩4,000)

#### (2) Option 2

Take the **Light Rail** from Gimhae Int'l Airport to Sasang Station and transfer to Busan Metro Line 2 at Sasang → ride to Centum City Station

#### (3) Option 3

Go to **the taxi** stand in front of the airport exit-> Take a taxi and ask the driver to go to the APEC Climate Center, or show the address in Korean (Taxi fare: approximately 4000,000~30,000)

#### 3. Portable Wi-Fi

There will be 10 portable Wi-Fi devices available at the Venue. Each device can support up to 5 users. More information will be provided soon.


# 4. Plugs

You will need an adapter to be able to use the South Korea plugs - there are two types -

Type C (right): Also known as the Europlug with two round pins.

Type F (left): Known as the Schuko plug, also has two round pins.

Devices rated for 220–240V should work without a voltage converter


# 7. Reception dinner

# 8.Weather

Please prepare for summer weather in Busan, with average temperatures: 25–30°C (77–86°F) and relatively high humidity.

# 9. Safety

Busan is reasonably safe, but crime does exist, therefore, precautions must be taken. Be street wise, and don't carry all your cash with you - use your hotel safe that is available in all rooms. Use marked taxis or buses to move between areas. Try not to have cameras/electronic devices loose and try to make yourself look like a local. Do not allow strangers to assist you at ATM's. Try to explore in groups and stick to well-lit streets especially at night and always use crosswalks; traffic can be busy in city areas
