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CMIP International Project Office

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 - Funding for at least 3 staff members for 5 years
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 - Detlef Stammer/Mike Sparrow/myself were involved in the decision making process
 - Final negotiations between ESA and contractor
- Third step: hiring of additional staff members
 - Target communication and technical support
 - Will start once the CMIP IPO Director is in place (should be beginning of 2022)
 - Expected to start first few months of 2022

- Currently undergoing final "friendly-users" testing
- Planning to submit it before the end of 2021, input received by end of January
- Will use CMIP IPO to help with analysis & summary

CMIP7 planning

- Meeting with WGCM leadership (and others?) before summer to discuss findings from the survey (and using group feedback from this meeting)
- Identification of the best team to carry the vision forward -> need to think of CMIP7 optimally (along the lines of what Ben discussed)
- Timeline (from Greg)
 - WGI approval in ~2029, so working backward, that would mean literature and model output cutoff in ~2027-2028, which would mean we need to be ready to launch CMIP7 experiments in about 2025-26
